

NEW RESTRICTIONS (Wales)

The Welsh government has today announced a new temporary lockdown applying to all of Wales.

The 'fire-break' will start at 6pm on Friday 23 October and end on Monday 9 November.

All **hospitality businesses**, including cafes, restaurants, and pubs (unless they provide take-away or delivery services), close contact services, such as hotels must close.

GRANT SUPPORT FOR BUSINESS

- Every business covered by the small business rates relief will receive a £1,000 payment.
- Small and medium-sized retail, leisure and hospitality businesses, which have to close will receive a one-off payment of up to £5,000.
- There will also be additional discretionary grants and support for smaller businesses, which are struggling.
- We recommend contacting your local authority regarding these grants and the application process.

OTHER SUPPORT

- Throughout October, businesses can use the CJRS (furlough).
- From 1st November, employers can use the new 'enhanced' Job Support Scheme. No details have been released as yet, we will update our <u>NEWS</u> page when they are.
- Remember, the deadline for a business to apply for a bounceback loan is 30th November.
