FURLOUGH

The Job Support Scheme that was due to come into force this month has been paused. Instead, the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (furlough) has been extended until December. This extension covers England, Scotland, and Wales. The furlough can be total if no work is available or flexible if you can trade for takeaways for example. Employees are to be paid 80% of their usual wage up to a maximum of £2,500. This can then be claimed back. Employers will still be required to pay any relevant employer's national insurance/pensions contributions. To be eligible, your employees must have had a payslip processed through RTI before 30th October 2020. You do not need to have used furlough previously.

If we had claimed on your behalf previously, we will do so again, As before, we will not be charging for this service. If we did not claim on your behalf previously, but you would like us to do so, please get in touch through support@roslyns.co.uk We are waiting for guidance from HMRC on when claims can begin. As soon as we know more, we will update you.

GRANTS

Grants are available as previously announced.
To confirm for those in England;
For properties with a rateable value of £15k or under
£1,334 per month or £667 per two weeks
For properties with a rateable value of between £15k-£51k
£2,000 per month or £1,000 per two weeks;
For properties with a rateable value of £51k or over
£3,000 per month or £1,500 per two weeks.

You apply for these through your local authority.
There are also discretionary grants available through your local authorities.
